Thomas Louis Holland was born August 06, 1948 in Tsingtao (now Qingdao), Shandong, China. He was the first child and only son born to Dr. Ira Howard Holland and Beverly Orrell Myers. Dr. & Mrs. Holland were both teachers with advanced degrees and missionaries and as such they traveled the world. Thomas was married twice but only had 2 biological children with his 2nd wife Anne. He also claimed 3 stepchildren (a daughter from Anne's 1st marriage and stepdaughter and a stepson from his last relationship).

He wore many hats, Chess Master, Genius, MENSA member, USMC Veteran, Father, Grandfather, Pressman, Pilot, Realtor, Broker, Appraiser, Stockbroker, Business Owner, Day Trader, College Graduate, Substitute Teacher, World Traveler, Gambler, Jokester, even Doppelganger!



A bit a genealogical History...

Tom's pedigree on his Mother's side is rather impressive. *Almost all* her lines are Pre-Colonial America families. He has one Mayflower Family, is related to at least 29 U.S. Presidents, has founding family lines in Massachusetts, Connecticut, Vermont and Iowa. His family lines can be traced back before the 1300's in England and Ireland. In a DNA test Tom also had 29% Jewish DNA which also but not surprisingly found him to be mostly English, German and a little Irish.

Notable Family Members & Related Individuals :

Cecil Harvey Myers (Grandfather): Owner and Manufacturer. The Kari-keen Company. They manufactured the Kari-keen cases for the Original Ford Model A cars and for the Kari-keen Airplanes. He bankrupted his own company in 1930 when he had ordered 1 million cases to be produced and Ford put a trunk in the cars that year and they were no longer needed. His son Hubert Allen Myers was an engineer for Howard Hughes. Together they had a patent for a Hydraulic clutch and variable speed drive. Also a WWI veteran he served in the British Army in Canada. Received British War Medal, Allied Victory Medal and Silver War Badge.

Willard Kidder (3rd Great Uncle) : Owner and Founder of the mill in Terre Haute, In which was the original producer of Gold Medal Flour Mill. Yes, the same Gold Medal Flour we see in grocery stores today. When he died the Mill was run by his son who died years later and the family sold the business.

Lt. Ralph Sprague (9th Great Grandfather) : Came to America in 1629 with his two brothers aboard the Lions Whelp, was prominent in the early settlement of Charlestown, Mass., where he was several years a selectman; in 1630, first constable, in 1639 lieut. and in 1637 and 8 years after, a representative.

Walt Disney : The beloved founder of Disneyland and the Disney Company is also a Ralph Sprague descendant and distantly Tom's 5th cousin 2x removed.

Lucille Ball : Best known for her role on the I Love Lucy Show, Lucy is another Sprague Descendant and also a 8th cousin 1x removed of Tom's.



Doppelganger...

Rev. William Jacob Holland, PhD, DD, LLD was born in Jamaica August 16, 1848 (100 years and 10 days to the day of Tom) while his parents were missionaries. William was an accomplished scientist best known for “The Butterfly Book”, which is still used as the standard today. He was a very accomplished man. Second pastor of the First United Presbyterian Church of Pittsburgh (now Bellefield Presbyterian Church). He was the eighth Chancellor of the University of Pittsburgh (1891–1901) and Director of the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh. And Thomas Holland is his Doppelganger. The only difference is William had grey eyes.

The Holland Story ...

Thomas is the last male Holland in his direct line. An only son of an only son, a descendant of the Holland Family of Alexandria, VA. They owned a plantation there where Robert E Lee had a nearby home. A lost family heirloom was a picture of Tom's Great-Great-grandfather sitting horseback shaking hands with Robert E Lee and it was inscribed "To my dear friend, William Holland. Yours truly Robert E Lee" William Holland's son William had also been a confederate soldier under the command of General Lee. After the civil war ended and the family plantation was taken for by the railroad (a street named Holland Ln remains and railroad tracks)

William James Holland, II. (1843- abt. 1888)

William was born in either Baltimore MD or Alexandria, VA. He married a German/Prussian immigrant who was a widow with 3 children and 10 years his senior. They had 4 children and the youngest Louis was Tom's grandfather. The family trade was meat packing. William Holland had owned a butcher Shop in Alexandria VA on Market Street. He was known as one of the finest butchers in town. In 1883 the family relocated to Chicago, IL because at the time it had become the Meat Packing Capital of the world and William had thought it was a great opportunity. After arriving they opened a butcher shop and grocer called Holland & Son's. By 1885 they had two locations one was located on N. Western Ave run by William and the other on State St. Run by Louis' older brother Albert. About 1888 William passed away at age 44 and young Luis had to drop out of school at age 14 to help run the family business. They eventually closed one store and the other remained opened until 1926 when Al died from cancer and Louis could not run things himself.

Louis James Holland (1875-1951)

Louis was the youngest child born to his parents in 1875 in Alexandria Virginia. He had married Jeanette Haase the daughter of a local cigar maker, Julius Haase who had emigrated to New York from Prussia during the Civil War. In 1909 Their daughter Dorothy Frances was born she lived to be 103! In 1914 Ira Howard Holland was born to the couple and then Jeanette tragically died from breast cancer in 1925 at age 48 leaving him to raise his children, Dorothy age 15 and Ira age 11. Louis also had to take on the care of his brother-in-law Charlie, an ex-Vaudeville star, who had become blind as well as his aging father-in-law, Julius he moved into a house for aging Jews.

Louis had worked a manager for the Tea Bus Company but was laid off a month before he was eligible for his pension. Because Louis did not get the opportunity to attend school past the 8th grade and he saw how times were changing he was very big on education. He urged his children to attend college. Fran obtained a Bachelors 'degree and was a gym teacher for a short period. She married and had two children and remained in her father's home until 1951 when 1st her young husband died at age 33 from a heart attack and then her father died later that year. Louis was 71 when he died from lung cancer.

Ira Howard Holland (1914-1980)


Dr Ira Howard Holland was born in Chicago, IL. As a child Ira had developed Rickets Disease. His mother died when he was only 11 and she had been sick for quite some time before then. His sister Dorothy Francis took on the motherly roll and he had resented her for it. He was a Golden Gloves boxing champion. Ira excelled in school and took a particular interest in Sociology and History. While completing his undergraduates at Morningside College in Iowa he met Beverly Orrell Myers. In 1944 they married in S. Bend, Indiana where Ira was a YMCA secretary. They had 3 children Thomas, Harriet and Nancy.. Ira obtained his doctorate in Sociology at Columbia University, writing his doctoral dissertation titled "A study of interracial relationships and practices in selected YMCA's " based upon his experiences while serving as Secretary for the YMCA in Seoul, Korea. He was a professor of Psychology, Philosophy, Sociology. He was teaching Sociology at Edward Waters College, where he was murdered by a student on Jan 4, 1980.

Thomas Louis Holland (1948-2020)

Thomas was a stubborn child. He often questioned everything and debated with everyone, so his parents called him "The Doubting Thomas".

A survivor from day one...

Thomas was born in Tsingtao, China while his parents were missionaries. His mother did not eat because she felt bad for the people of this village and therefore could not produce breast milk to feed him. She almost killed him via starvation when a villager kept him alive with potato water.

The early years...

After China, Ira and Beverly returned to the United States with their 6-month-old son through Alaska in February 1949. A few months later Ira had become the Secretary of the YMCA in Seoul Korea and off they went for another year Overseas. They returned in 1950 and moved to NYC so Ira could finish his doctorates at Columbia University.

In November 1951 Harriet was born in Oklahoma City. At the time Ira was teaching at the Oklahoma State University. In 1953 Ira resigned his position after a heated argument with the school administration for his views on desegregation. They had confronted him for having a black student at his house at the end of the semester during a project or a party. That night Tom clearly remembered KKK burning across on their front lawn. He vividly remembered his father challenging them to take him on like a real man and not hide behind their hoods like cowards.



Next, Dr. and Mrs. Holland now a family of four packed up and moved to Tallahassee, Florida where Nancy Sue was born in March of 1954. After about a year they went to Indianapolis



In 1956 they moved to a more tolerant California. They lived in La Verne where Ira taught Psychology and Philosophy at Mt. San Antonio College in Walnut.

A year later Ira joined the faculty at Upland University and headed the Sociology Department. So the family moved to Upland. Tom would proudly tell everyone they lived near the dump though his mother was completely mortified. The dump was Tom's favorite place to explore with his siblings. They liked to catch and collect horned toads. He also befriended a lost baby raccoon who had been too young to survive on his own and made it his pet for a short time before his parents made him release him back into the wild.



They also lived in Anaheim then moved to Monterey Park when Ira became part of the faculty at East Los Angeles College.

By the time Tom was in the 8th grade he was already 6'1" and taller than his father, his male teacher and the school principal. He always said if he had the legs to match his torso, he would have been the next Larry Byrd. He towered over all his friends and was a defender of the nerdy types that were typically picked on by the bullies in the school. That year he also ran for student body vice president and was elected. The same year his sister Harriet, ran for school librarian and he was her Campaign Manager. She also won though she always attributed this being his sister because she was so quiet that nobody knew who she was.

In the ninth grade Tom attended Alhambra high school. He joined the school band and play the clarinet. He marched in the front row of the Rose parade pretending to play the trombone that year because that person who played it normally, had been sick. He also played baseball and had dreams of becoming a pro until he realized his knee would not allow this.


In Toms 11th grade year the Hollands went to live in Cairo Egypt for a couple years while Ira taught at the American University in Cairo. Tom finished High School a year early graduating in 1965 with honors from Cairo American College, which was a college preparatory school and previously a palace.

The College Years...


By this time the Hollands had traveled the world through England, France, Germany, Italy, Budapest, New Zealand, Lebanon, India, Kenya, Croatia, . Czechoslovakia, Egypt and many other places.

After High school Tom began attending The American University in Cairo. He studied there for one-year majoring in Political Science and Economics. While there he and three friends decided to make some hash Brownies. They left them to cool and while they were gone a friend of theirs stopped by and started to eat them not knowing what they contained. He wound up eating the whole batch and passed out on their couch for four days.

In 1966 Hollands packed up and went back to California to live in Monterey Park again while Ira resumed teaching at East Los Angeles Community College. He moved out pf his family home at 18 and went to work for the Los Angeles Times while attending school. Tom ran for class Vice President and won. He belonged to a society there they called "The Family". This group of students were the popular ones who ran the school. Tom also met the love of his life there, Anne Metchnikoff. He chased off all her boyfriends and was very persistent until she agreed to a date. He had wanted to marry her, but his father Dr. Holland did not approve because he felt at 19 they were too young and had wanted him to pursue a doctorate first. Tom Graduated from East Los Angeles Community College "Cum Laude" and "Alpha Gamma Sigma". He obtained his AA in Political Science and Economics. He and Anne eventually parted ways both getting married a year later to other people. But their story does not end there.

After graduating from Jr, College Tom went on to UCLA. He worked in the mailroom at the L.A. Times while earning his B.A. in Political Science. As a result of being in the Marine Corps he did not finish his degree until 1971. He continued to go to school for his Masters and was one thesis short of obtaining it.

Call of Duty...

In 1969 Tom was drafted into the USMC. He married Terry Tarrant in S. Carolina because at the time you could make a common law contract in that state. He told his family he needed someone to get himself through boot camp. He was a Rifleman and a tech of small arms. He also had a Marksman Badge. He served a tour during the Vietnam War. He was promoted three times. After his obligation expired in 1973, he served 2 years as a Reservist in the United States Army. Ultimately discharging from the Military in March of 1975.




Post War....

After completing training for the Army Reserves, he had made some good money in Real Estate but near the end of 1975 Terry filed for divorce. He had wanted children and she did not. She took him to the cleaners, and he left the marriage with only the shirt on his back. Leaving her all the marital assets, properties and cash. It is suspected she did not like the fact he was part of the underground that hid out Patty Hearst. He never really spoke of Terry or what happened there.

After his failed marriage he decided to seek out Anne. It had been about 7 years since they last saw each other. He told her he loved her and always had and never forgot her and invited her to dinner at a really expensive restaurant in Santa Monica. He told her to order whatever she wanted off the menu but when she saw him ordering the cheapest thing and a glass of water, she knew he was in trouble with money and she did the same. He knew he was going to marry this woman. On May 27, 1977 they were married In Las Vegas Nevada,






Proud Papa...


Enter the Colonel...

She was her trade school Valedictorian in 2010. 

Jr. High Graduation – Salutatorian

In May of 1981 Lara Lynn was born. This child they nicknamed sunshine because she was a smiley child and seemed to live in her own little world. One time the girls were playing while Tom was sleeping (he worked the Graveyard shift) and they accidentally woke him up. They knew he would be mad and they would be in trouble so they ran. They were making such a quick getaway Lara slipped on the stairs and tumbled down. He felt so guilty he gave them grape licorice. She has one son Daniel.



He was a strict father accepting only the best from his children. He was also a fun Dad. He never let us “just win.” He was ruthless when playing board games and playing Monopoly forget about it. He would get all your money because you would land on his Real Estate and he was the bank (as a child I always thought he was cheating). He would tell you that you were making bad real Estate investments when you would purchase the cheaper properties. Games of Risk could last days or weeks. He would slaughter you at chess but one day he was actually beaten by a 10-year-old Zoiya. Best day ever!

He taught his children at an early age the value of a dollar. Once when I was 5 or 6 he got me this my little pony that I wanted but it stayed in the closet until I had earned it. Dear old Dad used to say “No body ever gave me anything for free”.

During Halloween he used to take us Trick-or-treating and the deal was we could get as much candy as we could carry. So we would get pillow cases but after a while when they were about ½ full they got too heavy to carry and he would wind up carrying them for us. When we got back to the house he would check it to make sure it is all good but then he would “tax us” and take some and tell us “everybody in America has to pay taxes might as well get used to it.”

Dear old Dad...

Tom always has his “As dear old Dad used to say...” life lessons.

1. As Dear ole’ Dad used to say “Son when someone starts with that good old boy home spun routine on you, do a quick reach round and see if you still have your wallet.”
2. As Dear ole’ Dad used to say “When someone says ‘it’s only money’ he’s talking about yours and not his”.
3. As Dear ole’ Dad used to say “Son life is good when you have money in the bank and cattle on the range”.
4. As Dear ole’ Dad used to say “Son if making money were really easy everybody would have a lot of it “.
5. As Dear ole’ Dad used to say “Win some lose some. When some listen when does the winsome start? “
6. As Dear ole’ Dad used to say “Hindsight is 20/40 you forget the state of mind you were in at the time”.

Always the Entrepreneur...

Tom had many businesses over his lifetime. Starting off at a young age with a lemonade stand he saw every person and everything as an opportunity. He also had a paper route and had gotten up very early each morning to ensure the papers were delivered before going to school. He helped parents breed and raise Beagle Puppies. The family had a pair of Beagles Duke and Miss Muffet. Because of this he was always partial to hound dogs. He loved Beagles and Basset hounds.

As a teenager he started a business mowing lawns for his neighbors and before long he had a large customer base. When the family was getting ready to move to Cairo, Egypt due to Ira’s new assignment he sold his lawn business.

In the late 70’s and early 80’s he and Anne had a successful real estate brokerage called All Valley Real Estate. At this point they were on top of the world. this is About the time he would meet his mentor Harold Springer. Harold had become like a father figure to him and a was successful businessman and real estate tycoon. Anne and Tom had accumulated about 6 rental properties throughout the San Fernando Valley and Bell Canyon. They had two apartment buildings in Burbank and one in Glendale and then their beautiful family home in Granada Hills above the Knollwood Estates. It was definitely my favorite family home 6 bedrooms 4 bathrooms and a 20

x 40 foot swimming pool. He was building a motel and had about 800,000 liquid cash in the bank. He taken a job at Dean Witter as a stockbroker. All the girls went to private schools. Anne had a nice Cadillac And Tom had a Mercedes. Things were seemingly good but Anne had no idea what was really going on.

The Murder of Ira Howard Holland...

For Christmas in 1979 they took a trip to St Augustine Beach FL To stay with his parents so they could meet their new granddaughter then visit with Denise. They visited with Harriet who lived in nearby Orlando and her husband. On the plane ride there they had met the cast of the Dukes of Hazzard. All of which had a fun time playing with their new baby.

On January 4th 1980 after just returning from their trip, they would get the phone call that would change everything. Ira had been murdered by a student, Charles Wesley Brown. A story that made it to every newspaper across the country. Ira had given this particular student an incomplete because the guy never showed up for class and he didn't believe in giving "F's" because he felt as though it discouraged the student so he would rather give them an incomplete. This student obviously did not take the news very well and while Ira was holding office time He came into the office and shot him three times. Mr Brown an apparent paranoid schizophrenic was found incompetent to stand trial and sent to a mental institution for two years. As the story goes Mr Brown didn't make it very far but a couple of blocks from the mental institution when he met with an unfortunate incident and was shot to death in an alleyway.

Shortly after Ira's death Tom had a nervous breakdown. His whole drive in life was to shove it to his dad how successful he was and now that was gone . This began just slow downward spiral up the Holland Empire.

From Riches to Rags...

Unfortunately, by 1986 they lost everything. He was taken advantage of by almost everybody who is working for him they even stole a \$75,000 backhoe. He lost everything on the stock market trying to make \$1,000,000. Even losing their family home for one payment left at \$2500 on a loan shark loan which he was 15 minutes late paying. The Cadillac was repossessed, the girls eventually enrolled in public schools , the Mercedes went back and a beat up station wagon was purchased. They were moved into a 3 bedroom rent-a-wreck with no air conditioning no yard to speak up or pool. And even after all of this Anne still try to make their marriage work.

New Beginings...

In 1987 after Anne asked Tom to move out, he took an apartment in Reseda and had to take a cooking class. He was never a good cook, but man could he BBQ. He had gone back to work for the LA times and after receiving Employee of the month in 1990 he was promoted to Pressman. He met his best friend Phil Mulligan there.

In 1989 he met a woman named Glenna who was a schoolteacher with no children of her own and they lived together about 7 years. Tom had gone to work to build up his fortune working sometimes triple shifts at the time always working Holidays because it payed double time. He got his pilot's license and began flying as a hobby.

After he split with Glenna, he bought a house in North Hills. During this time, he got involved in many get rich quick schemes none of which panned out. He had started making beef jerky in the spare time and was taking it to work with him when he got his idea where is next venture. He and Phil bought a bunch of the humidifiers and began making beef jerky of all flavors. They would sell the bags at The Times and were making quite a bit of money as it was in such high demand that they couldn't even make it quick enough. Eventually this operation

was shut down by the health Department Then he tried this worm farm scheme. 20- 3 cubic yard containers in his back yard only they were buying the worms now fully grown for less money then they sold the baby ones to him. He then tried a windshield repair company that could repair small cracks and pits in your windshield in the comfort of your own home. It did not make it either. He began trading stocks again. He went to school to become a Real Estate Appraiser

In late 1995 he met Carla and she had two children Heather 17 and Frank was in his 20's. Heather had a 1-year old daughter Melody. Tom nicknamed her Boo and she became his 1st grandchild. He and Carla bought and apartment building in Van Nuys. They eventually bought the house next door, then the one down the street. In 2000, he opened Diversified Capital Enterprises and had a rapidly growing Real Estate Appraiser business. He sent everyone to school to learn how to do appraisals, Phil, Heather, Denise and Carla. He had up to 7 guys working for him at one time. He decided to renew his Real Estate license and quickly got his Brokerage up and running again. All Valley Real Estate. In 2004 they moved to a house in North Hollywood because it was a real estate deal gone bad. He made some bad investments and got scammed on a TV device that took him for \$50k and Phil for \$100K. The Real Estate Appraiser business tanked in 2010 when the banks began using their own in-house people. After that they sold everything and moved to Lancaster.

In 2011 he went in on a joint venture with a guy named Butch called Binary Options Mania. People paid a monthly fee to follow them on trading binary options on the Nasdaq. He also tried to do a joint Venture with his friend Mr. K called The Vegas Syndicate but thanks to the convenience of sports betting on the internet it didn't get off the ground.

In 2017 he, Carla and Frank moved to Phoenix AZ. where he purchased a house and died on April 26, 2020 with his family at his side. His body was donated to science as he wished.

My Dad was a man who lived a large life and this memoir is only a brief outline of events. It would take lots of research to write his full life's story. No one truly knows what he owned, had or what his worth was when he died. A will has yet to surface. We know stuff is out there, but Tom had a knack for burying things. I jokingly said if I ever write a book or make a movie it would be intitled "*Down the Rabbit Hole: The Quest After the Flying Dutchman*".



